❖ EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This report provides a comprehensive overview of the NCC activities conducted by the 1 Mah Arty Bty NCC Unit at Rajaram College, Kolhapur, throughout the academic year 2022-23. Activities are categorized based on their event type, offering insights into the unit's engagement in celebratory events, competitions, remembrance events, awareness and unity initiatives, felicitation and inspiration events, community service endeavours, and patriotic activities.

- Trained cadets across multiple disciplines.
- Organized 15+ high-impact activities and events.
- Sent 10 cadets to prestigious national-level NCC camps.
- Conducted 5 social responsibility initiatives.
- Celebrated key national events with record participation and engagement.
- Achieved 100% success rate in B & C certificate examinations.
- Implemented advanced training methodologies, making cadets SSB-ready.

❖ ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

➤ **YOGA DAY (21ST JUNE 2024):** Our NCC unit celebrated International Yoga Day with 150 cadets actively participating in a structured yoga session led by trained instructors. The session focused on improving physical fitness, mental wellness, and stress management through various asanas and breathing exercises.



➤ **TIRANGA RALLY (13TH AUGUST 2024):** To instill a deep sense of nationalism and unity, cadets participated in a grand Tiranga Rally, carrying the national flag and marching across the city. Over 200 cadets took part, spreading awareness about the sacrifices of freedom fighters and the importance of national integrity.



➤ **INDEPENDENCE DAY (15TH AUGUST 2024):** The Independence Day celebrations were marked by a flag hoisting ceremony, an NCC parade, and cultural performances. The unit displayed a synchronized march-past, saluting the national flag in the presence of dignitaries. 20 senior cadets were honored for their outstanding performance in NCC activities.

➤ **ENROLLMENT-I (AUGUST 2024):** The first phase of the NCC the enrollment drive saw a huge response, with 250+ students registering for selection. After a rigorous selection process based on physical fitness, discipline, and interest in NCC, 120 cadets (85 boys & 35 girls) were enrolled.



➤ **SWOT ANALYSIS (SEPTEMBER 2024):** A Strategic Strength, Weakness, Opportunity, Threat (SWOT) Analysis session was conducted to evaluate the overall performance of cadets and identify areas of improvement. This session helped in devising strategies for better training and leadership development.



➤ **GANDHI JAYANTI (2ND OCTOBER 2024):** Cadets paid tribute to Mahatma Gandhi by participating in a prayer meet, cleanliness drive, and discussions on his principles of non-violence and truth. A skit was performed on the importance of self-reliance and the Swadeshi movement.

➤ **CLEANLINESS DRIVE (3RD OCTOBER 2024):** Inspired by the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, 150 cadets took part in a cleanliness drive in public areas, schools, and slum localities. The cadets also organized an awareness campaign on proper waste disposal and hygiene maintenance.



➤ **BOOK REVIEW COMPETITION (10th OCTOBER 2024):** To encourage intellectual growth and critical thinking, a Book Review Competition was held. 30 cadets presented their reviews on books related to leadership, patriotism, and military strategy, with top performers receiving certificates and medals.

➤ **AITSC CADETS FELICITATION (OCTOBER 2024):** Cadets who participated in the All India Thal Sainik Camp (AITSC) were felicitated for their hard work and dedication. These cadets had undergone rigorous training and represented our unit at a national level, showcasing their expertise in weapon handling, obstacle training, and map reading.



➤ **ENROLLMENT-II (NOVEMBER 2024):** The second phase of enrollment inducted 80 more cadets, increasing the total strength of the unit. The new recruits underwent orientation sessions and were introduced to the fundamentals of drill, discipline, and NCC ethics.



➤ **NCC DAY CELEBRATION (24th NOVEMBER 2024):** The 76th NCC Raising Day was celebrated with parades, cultural performances, and interactive sessions with ex-NCC cadets and officers. Senior cadets shared their SSB interview experiences, motivating juniors to pursue careers in the armed forces.



➤ **SPORTS COMPETITION (24th NOVEMBER 2024):** To promote sportsmanship, fitness, and teamwork, a sports competition was held, featuring events. Over 100 cadets participated, with winners receiving medals and appreciation certificates.

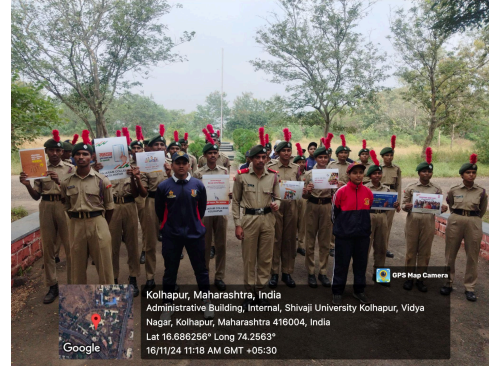


➤ **CONSTITUTION DAY (26TH NOVEMBER 2024):** Cadets celebrated Constitution Day by taking an oath to uphold the values of the Indian Constitution. A special lecture was conducted on the rights and duties of citizens, emphasizing the importance of constitutional literacy.

➤ **STREET PLAY (DECEMBER 2024):** A social awareness street play was organized by NCC cadets on topics like drug abuse, gender equality, and patriotism. The play was performed in public places, schools, and local markets, drawing a significant audience.



➤ **ENERGY CONSERVATION DAY:** Energy Conservation Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm and active participation from students, faculty, and staff. The event aimed to raise awareness about environmental issues and encourage sustainable practices.



➤ **YODDHA:** A Defence Study Group is a specialized training or discussion group focused on preparing individuals for careers in the armed forces and defense services. These groups provide guidance for entrance exams like NDA, CDS, AFCAT, and SSB interviews. They also cover military strategies, current affairs, leadership skills, and physical fitness. Such groups help aspiring candidates develop discipline, problem-solving abilities, and a deep understanding of national security.



➤ **REPUBLIC DAY (26TH JANUARY 2025):** The Republic Day celebrations witnessed cadets participating in a grand parade, flag hoisting ceremony, and cultural performances. Select cadets had the honor of performing in the Guard of Honour in front of dignitaries and military officials.
